
You have just had a small piece of tissue taken from your vulval area. To encourage healing we recommend that you keep the area clean and dry.

You may have slight bleeding from the biopsy site and may need to wear a soft sanitary pad or panty liner.

If you wish, check the area daily with a hand mirror to make sure its healing.

If a stitch was required this will dissolve in about five days.

If the area becomes painful, red, or inflamed, call the team at ASC Gynaecology.
